Aitong Discovery & Empowerment Center tries to encourage people to become more familiar with their own ecosystem and use it to benefit themselves in sustainable ways. These ways include practices or skills such as: tree nursery, bee hiving, beading, dance, meetings, eco-clubs, paper briquettes, education on garbage, job hunting skills, and computer skills. Kicheche regularly supplies books for the library.

Ace Bandages, Band-Aids, Cold Tabs, First Aid Kits, Sanitary Napkins, Splints, Tampons, Tongue Depressors, and Tweezers

Testing Kits:

Malaria Testing Kits ('RDTs' – Rapid Diagnostic Test Kits with Reagent) and Pregnancy Testing Kits

Medications:

Alcohol Gel, Antibiotics, Antifungal Cream, Aspirin, Burn Cream, Eye Drops, Ibuprofen, and Paracetamol

Project

Naboisho Primary School is a small community school serving 95 children from ages 6 through 10 years old on the edge of the Masai Mara wildlife conservancy. The school is run by the community and started in 2012.

Many of the parents of the students make very little because they are farmers, making it difficult to contribute towards the development of the school. These challenges, among others, have put the school in a situation whereby school supplies are very limited, and hence the need to seek assistance.

Needs**General School Supplies:**

Book Bags, Chalk, Colored Construction Paper, Colored Pencils, Crayons, Erasers, Glue Sticks, Handheld Pencil Sharpeners, Markers, Pencils, Pencil Cases/Bags, and Pens

Kenyan curriculum school books:

Approximately USD \$5 per book – to order from our office.

Wall Charts:

(English and Kiswahili) Human Body, Language, and World Maps

Text/Reading Books:

(English and Kiswahili) Age Appropriate Story Books and Local Kiswahili Curriculum Books

Sports/Outdoor Activity:

Inflation Pumps, Jump Ropes, Netball/Basketballs, Soccer Balls, and Whistles

First Aid/Health:

Antibiotic Ointment, Band-Aids, and Sanitary Napkins

Nanyuki Childrens' Home serves over 80 children from infancy to the age of 16.

Needs**General School Supplies:**

Colored Pencils and Crayons

Sports/Outdoor Activity:

Frisbees, Inflation Pumps, Jump Ropes, and Soccer Balls

Clothing:

New or Gently Used Children's Shoes

Linens:

Bath Towels, bed sheets

Health/Personal Grooming:

Band-Aids, Bars of Soap, Combs, Sanitary Napkins, Shampoos, Toothbrushes, and Toothpaste

Specifically for Children:

Powered Baby Formula

Note

Candy and balloons are not on the needs list as they are harmful for the children and the environment for the following reasons:

- Few of the children benefiting from these projects have access to toothpaste, toothbrushes, or a dentist. The candy promotes cavities.
- The balloons once they become deflated are a choking hazard for local wildlife.

Instead of taking candy or balloons, use that space for additional requested supplies, as they are priceless.
